### CREATING A SUSTAINABLE CONSTRUCTION CULTURE WITH THE PASSIVE HOUSE CONCEPT

We cordially invite you to the 11<sup>th</sup> International Passive House Conference 2007 in Bregenz on Lake Constance. Architecture and the passive house is the focus of the meeting this year. Many projects demonstrating an architecture suitable for the future using the passive house standard are presented. The technical quality and architectural quality are no contradiction, in fact they combine most beautifully here. In addition to the focus on architecture, the conference offers talks on the topics of

**renovation using passive house components, international passive house projects, non-residential buildings, realisation and financing as well as domestic services technology.**

On Sunday April, 15<sup>th</sup> 2007, excursions offer the opportunity to view passive houses in Vorarlberg and southern Germany under expert guidance.

The meeting is being held in Bregenz for the second time. This is to show appreciation to the leading role which the state of Vorarlberg has in energy efficient construction and architecture. Since the days of the „Vorarlberger Bauschule“ in the 60s and the movement of the „Vorarlberger Baukünstler“ in the 80s, Vorarlberg is internationally recognized for its clearly delineated architecture and sophisticated simplicity, for its well anchored and lively building culture, which emphasises high quality and continuous development. Contemporary architecture and sustainable construction are not opposites in Vorarlberg: 70 % of all newly constructed dwellings fulfil the criteria for the ecological residential building subsidy. If judged by its population size, Vorarlberg has the largest density of passive houses in Austria, maybe even in Europe. Major recognition is also due to the state for the requirement that all social housing from 2007 on will be built to the passive house standard. This means a long term securing of social housing construction because the heating cost subsidy is already two to four times the total heating costs required of a passive house. The Vorarlberg Energy Institute, which celebrated 20 years in 2005, is actively involved in this development.

On the federal level the programmes „House of the future“ from the Austrian Federal Ministry for Traffic, Innovation and Technology (BmVIT) and „Klima:aktiv haus“ (= Climate:active house) from the Austrian Federal Ministry for Agriculture and Forestry, Environment and Water Economics (BmLFUW), provide an important contribution to the spreading of the word about the passive house standard.
